

PARISH MEMBERSHIP: Welcome to Saint Margaret of Scotland Catholic Church! We are grateful for your worshipping with us. If you regularly attend Mass here in Maggie Valley, you are encouraged to register in the parish at the office during the week. Please note that a family must be registered at Saint Margaret's in order for their children to be enrolled in our religious education program.

MARRIAGE: A new set of guidelines for weddings at Saint Margaret's has been issued and is posted on the parish web site. Please note that only those who have some connection with this parish (such as being a member, or the child of a member) may get married here; weddings are also normally not scheduled during Advent or Lent because of the penitential nature of those seasons.

VISITING THE SICK: Please call the parish office to arrange for Communion or for the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick.

DAILY MORNING AND EVENING PRAYER: Morning Prayer is read at **7:20 AM daily**, and **Evening Prayer** is read at **5:00 PM daily**. Books are available for those who wish to participate; all are welcome.

Daily Mass: Mass is offered at 8:00 am daily. The sermons each morning at daily Mass for the next week will be on passages from Saint Paul's Letter to the Philippians. Mass on Saturday morning is from the Book of Divine Worship – The Missal.

AUDIO/VISUAL DEVELOPMENT AND LIVE STREAMING: The audio feed for all of our services (Daily Morning Prayer, Daily Evening Prayer, and Mass [both daily and Sunday]) is being transmitted on 90.3 FM. No log in or special equipment other than a radio is needed; the broadcast range appears to be about one mile.

SPECIAL COLLECTIONS: There will be a special collection coming up next weekend: **Seminarian Education Collection** on **7/8 November** collection will help meet the growing needs of seminarians.

October was Respect Life month, please check the parish website in the future for new resources for local mother's in need. There are also brochures in the narthex of the church.

BECOMING A CATHOLIC: If you are interested in becoming a Catholic, whether or not you have already been baptized in another non-Catholic church, please get in touch with the pastor (e-mail is best) or the parish office. We welcome you and look forward to sharing our faith.

Faith Formation: In person classes will begin meeting in the lower level of the old church at St John's on Nov 1, from 9-10:30am. The class schedule is 3rd & 4th grades - 1st Sunday of the month; 5th & 6th grades - 2nd Sunday of the month; 7th grade - 3rd Sunday of the month; 1st grade - 4th Sunday of the month. Sacramental preparation will continue as usual.

Gospel Weeklies will be available in ziploc bags for families who are homeschooling this year after Masses on 7/8 November. Please pick these up as they start Sunday, 15 November.

OFFICE HOURS: Beginning on 1 November 2020, the new office hours will be 9:30 am - 2:30 pm, Monday through Thursday. The office will continue to be closed on Fridays.
