Breakfast with Becket: after the 8:00AM Mass on Wednesday, 29 May in the Parish Hall with Exodus 26: Make a tabernacle of fine linen. What are some of the significant details you see in God's design for the curtains of linen? of goats' hair? for the design of the borders and sockets? of the veil and the screen? From this and other passages in the bible that mention these things, what can you learn about the purpose and significance of these parts of the Tabernacle? Practical reason expresses itself primarily in deliberation; and the virtue that uses practical reason correctly is the deliberative virtue of prudence. Aquinas frequently suggests deliberation, i.e., the process of considering how best to act in a given situation, is essential to responsibility. Join us in deliberating this coming Tuesday!

THE EPISCOPAL ORDINATION MASS FOR MICHAEL MARTIN, OFMCONV, will take place starting at 1 PM Wednesday, 29 May, at St. Mark's Catholic Church in Huntersville. There will be seating in the church as well as additional seating in the adjacent Monsignor Joseph A. Kerin Center. Mass-goers in the Kerin Center will view the Mass on a large projector screen. Mass-goers in both locations will have the opportunity to receive Holy Communion, and Bishop Martin will walk through the congregation in both locations to impart his first episcopal blessing. Each parish of the Diocese of Charlotte will receive 4 tickets for seats in the church and 5 tickets for seats in the Kerin Center; if you are able to attend and wish to obtain tickets, please contact the pastor. The ordination Mass will be livestreamed on the diocese's YouTube channel starting at 1 PM. Wednesday, and EWTN will broadcast the Mass starting at 3 PM, to help ensure that all the faithful are able to take part in this historic occasion for our diocese.
